## WSAB Meeting Participation Information

**In-person** participants may join at the physical location listed at the top of the agenda. If participants bring a device to join the meeting via Teams at the physical location, the system audio must be muted, or the audio should not be joined. This is to avoid disruptive feedback during the meeting. Audio will be provided through an onsite sound system.

**Remote** participants may join via Teams by internet or by phone.

- **To use the Teams online platform:** join with the link, meeting ID, and passcode listed at the top of the agenda and follow all prompts.

Participants will be placed on mute in “listen/watch only” mode until the public comment portion of the meeting. During the public comment portions, participants can use the raise hand function on the Teams videoconference. The hosting team will call on you when it is your time to speak, which will allow you to unmute yourself on your device and provide your comment.

Please be aware that the Microsoft Teams meeting may be recorded. Participants must consent to recording upon joining the meeting to be granted the ability to unmute their microphones. If you do not wish to consent to being recorded, please note your microphone capabilities will remain off during the recording.

- **To participate by telephone:** join with the number and passcode listed at the top of the agenda.

Participants will be placed on mute in “listen-only” mode until the public comment portion of the meeting. Once the public comment portions of the meeting begin, participants may dial \*5 (star five) when they wish to speak to be placed in a queue. The hosting team will unmute callers in order of request.

Comments may be limited to three minutes per speaker. Any comments will become part of the public record.
