Please emphasize the activities that will make a difference in wildfire prevention:

- 1) grid hardening with upgrading of wiring and fault sensors that can shut off current in the event of a line break.
- 2) Establish quantitative measures for progress, and assure accountability.
- 3) urge the CPUC to establish key minimal standards for grid fire safety, not to merely accept what the utilities propose.
- 4) programs for tree removal that are not based on evidence and may even worsen hazard conditions should be scrutinized and redesigned.
