October 2, 2020 – deadline to submit comments to WSD

October 31, 2020 – WSD submits recommendations to CPUC

**December 1, 2020** – CPUC considers Compliance Process



### Oversee Compliance with WMPs

- Outcome-based approach
- Goal to reduce wildfire risk
- Feedback to improve future WMPs
- Coordinate with Safety Enforcement Division

## Two Step Process for Overseeing Compliance



### **Assessments- Annual**

Outline 1-year Deliverables

- Review Reports:
  - Compliance Report
  - Independent Evaluator Reports
- Correction of Identified Deficiencies

### **Assessments- Ongoing**

- Inspections
- Audits
- Independent Evaluator Reports
- Customer Complaints
- Regular WSD Requested Reports
  - Tier 1 Advice Letters

## **Expedited Correction of WMP Defects**

Category	Correction
Category 1 - Severe	Immediate resolution
Category 2 - Moderate	<ul><li>1-2 months (in HFTD Tier 3)</li><li>3-6 months (in HFTD Tier 2)</li><li>6 months (if relevant to worker safety)</li><li>12 months or resolution scheduled in WMP update (other)</li></ul>
Category 3 - Minor	12 months or resolution schedule included in WMP update

# Consequences- Failure to Timely Resolve Defects or Substantially Comply with WMP

- Ongoing WSD compliance resolution efforts per PUC §326(a)(1)
- WSD and SED coordinate on appropriate enforcement actions as necessary per PUC §8389(g)
