### Agenda Item No. 14: Executive Officer's Report

Executive Officer Tony Marino presented the Executive Officer's report.

Chief of Investigations Jason Corsey provided an enforcement update explaining that three Notices of Probable Violation (NOPV) were mailed out on August 21, one

recommending referral to the Contractors State License Board (CSLB) and two recommending referral to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), all of which had a recommended penalty of education. Mr. Corsey explained that there may be a potential hearing date on November 16<sup>th</sup>.

Executive Officer Tony Marino presented the Education and Outreach update on outreach materials. A flyer was created for investigators to use in the field to provide information to excavators that are unaware of the call before you dig requirements.

Mr. Marino provided an update on the case management system that will go live in October with mobile components including iPhone and iPad access available later in the fall.

Mr. Marino reminded Board members to sign up for the multi-factor authentication.

Mr. Marino explained that SB 865 passed the legislature on August 31<sup>st</sup> and is awaiting the Governor's signature or veto.

Chair Voss asked for comments from the Board.

Board members commented in support of the flyer for outreach materials.

Chair Voss asked for comments from the public. There were none.

# <u>Agenda Item No. 15: Electronic Positive Response Extension – Consideration of Applications Received in the Month of August 2020</u>

Attorney Jeff Brooks presented a request from an operator seeking an extension of the deadline for the electronic positive response requirement for Board discussion and deliberation.

Chair Voss asked for comments from the Board.

Member Forte disclosed that she previously worked for the City of Santa Monica Water District and the City of Santa Monica but that it did not affect her ability to be objective.

Board members recognized that due to the Coronavirus Disease-19 (COVID-19) pandemic, operator's resources are strained and noted appreciation that the operator applied for the extension rather than wait until they were out of compliance.

# <u>Agenda Item No. 18: Discussion on Reasonable Care Standards Development for Trenchless Excavation Techniques</u>

Brittny Branaman, Budget and Policy Manager, presented the staff report on reasonable care standards development for trenchless excavation techniques.

Ms. Branaman discussed the participation of the workshop and the survey held in August 2020 by the Reasonable Care Committee. Participation in the workshop and survey was mainly represented by operators and operator-excavators, but there was limited participation from trenchless excavation contractors and subcontractors.

Ms. Branaman asked for all stakeholders reach out to their contacts who specialize in the field of trenchless excavation and encourage them to participate in October's workshop and survey and other upcoming opportunities to provide feedback.

Chair Voss asked for comments from the Board.

Board members acknowledged the workshop and survey was underrepresented by excavators themselves and encouraged excavators to review their best practices for trenchless excavation and send them to staff for developing further regulations for trenchless excavations.

Board members recommended staff perform outreach with suppliers to get contact information for excavators and inform them about the workshop. Member Bianchini provided excavator names for some entities in Northern California for staff to contact.

Chair Voss asked if there were public comments.

A member of the public asked that Southern California Boring Company be added to outreach list.
