**Agenda Item No. 2: Public Comment**

**Laura McWilliams** – read a letter from Sen. Hill’s office citing the San Bruno pipeline explosion on September 9, 2010, which resulted in the deaths of eight people and millions of dollars in damages. This incident occurred when an excavator ruptured a gas pipeline. Sen. Hill also gave his full support and praised the Board for accepting their roles in helping to investigate, regulate, and educate Californians in excavation rules and safety.

**Karen Mills, CA Farm Bureau Federation** – expressed her interest in how the Board will address the issues of continual excavation as it pertains to agricultural lands. California produces such a wide variety of agriculture and on any given property multiple agricultural

processes are used daily. This makes it difficult to create an all-encompassing process that will benefit all agriculture producers in California. She expressed her hope and interest in the future of the Board and its responsibility when it comes to the education and outreach workshops.

**Agenda Item No. 3: Welcome, from the Executive Officer**

Stated the importance of the Board considering the devastating incidents in San Bruno, Walnut Creek, Bakersfield, and Fresno, among others. These along with the fact that the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) has issued a letter to the California Attorney General outlining California’s pipeline safety inadequacies in 2015, 2016, and is expected to issue one for 2017 makes this Board imperative for the future safety of California. He welcomed each member and praised them for their commitment to the mission of the California Underground Facilities Safe Excavation Board.

## **Agenda Item No. 6: Annual Plan**

The Executive Officer presented the 2018 annual plan for the Underground Facilities Safe Excavation Board. The plan includes four strategic objectives, each of which continues several vital activities. The first objective is to focus on developing regulations to implement the legislative requirement for area of continual excavation tickets for agricultural and flood control activities. Next, developing education and enforcement program will focus on identifying relevant education, standards for demonstrating compliance, Board notification of incidents, and inter-agency enforcement coordination. Continual Learning will focus on baseline safety assessment and reasonable care standards, and finally stable funding will focus on fees levied on members of the one-call center and federal reimbursement through state based grants. The executive officer recommended four strategic activities to be led by Board members and that members pair up for these activities. The executive officer suggested they determine which members take ownership of which tasks. Chair Arden solicited volunteers, and members agreed on the following assignments:

**Arden** – Baseline safety assessment

**Bernacchi** – Standards for demonstrating compliance and Board notification of incidents

**Bianchini** – Baseline safety assessment

**Charland** – Standards for demonstrating compliance and Board notification of incidents

**Del Toro** – Identification of relevant education

**Johns** – Area of continual excavation outreach and piloting

**Johnson** – Identification of relevant education

**Voss** – Area of continual excavation outreach and piloting
