SUBJECT: Southern California Edison's Notification of Substantial Compliance in accordance with Senate Bill 247: Expanded Pole Brushing (VM-2) and Drought Relief Initiative (DRI) Inspections and Mitigations (VM-4)

Dear Ms. Thomas Jacobs,

In accordance with Senate Bill 247, SCE is providing notification to the Wildfire Safety Division that SCE has completed a substantial portion of its 2020 target for two of its 2020-2022 Wildfire Mitigation Plan vegetation management initiatives (VM-2 and VM-4). Initiative VM-2 is the performance of 200,000 pole brushes in High Fire Risk Areas (HFRA). As of October 30, 2020, SCE has completed over 197,000 pole brushes in HFRA. Initiative VM-4 is the performance of DRI annual inspections and complete prescribed mitigations in accordance with internal DRI program guidelines. As of October 30, 2020, SCE has achieved 80% of its 2020 target.
